

Counting Gumnuts with Biscuit — Addition Adventures

Year 4 addition worksheet themed through Burraga Hollow — Biscuit the dog hosts gumnut and Patch-the-Ball counting/addition tasks. Demonstrates theme-driven content generation.



Biscuit is waiting by the hollow log.

"G'day, friend! It's me, Biscuit. Today we're going on a little counting adventure around Burraga Hollow. Grab your pencil — let's have a go together!"

Biscuit says: "If a sum feels tricky, that's okay. Getting it wrong is just a friendly detour. Good trying — that's how we learn!"

Warm-up: Counting gumnuts

Biscuit keeps his gumnuts in a little basket. Let's help him count them into groups.

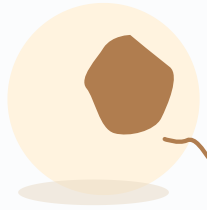
Q1. Biscuit found **4** gumnuts under the gum tree and **3** more by the creek. How many gumnuts altogether?

$$4 + 3 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

Q2. $6 + 5 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

Q3. $8 + 7 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

Patch the Ball: sharing game



*Patch — Biscuit's
favourite ball.*

Biscuit rolls Patch to a friend, and they roll it back. Every roll, they add more gumnuts to the pile by the hollow log.

Q4. The pile has **12** gumnuts. Pip rolls Patch back and adds **15** more. How many now?

$12 + 15 =$ _____

Q5. $23 + 14 =$ _____

Biscuit shows you how. For $23 + 14$, add the tens, then the ones:

1. Tens: $20 + 10 = 30$
2. Ones: $3 + 4 = 7$
3. Put them together: $30 + 7 = 37$

Q6. Bo the bandicoot dug up **18** gumnuts. Mae the cat brought **16** from the word log. How many gumnuts did the friends gather together?

Q7. Ollie the owl counted **25** stars, then **9** more peeked out from behind a cloud. How many stars did Ollie count in all? Show your working.
